





ERA Forum Discussion Topic:

Tailoring the Proposal Interface

PSM Vision

- Modernize the applications supporting the merit review process and the user experience via the development of a new application
- Reduce the administrative burden to the research community and NSF staff associated with preparation, submission, and management of proposals
- Increase efficiencies in proposal preparation, submission, and management
- Improve data quality
- Capture proposal content in a way that supports data analysis.

PSM Agile Concept Development

- o PSM is following an agile process to develop, review, and refine wireframes (webpage mockups) that leverages knowledge of the existing pain points
- External users will be engaged throughout the process to ensure the overall approach, workflows, and wireframes are consistent with user needs
- o Development of features and enhancements will be deployed incrementally

Identify Pain Points and Draft Improvements

• Leverage helpdesk, PSM survey, etc. to identify improvement opportunities and create initial concepts/mockups

Review Concepts with NSF Staff Working Group

- Review initial concepts and discuss at Working Group sessions
- Refine as needed

Review Wireframes with External Users

- Present and test wireframes with external users to validate and refine
- Usability sessions, Forum, etc.

Internal Validation and Execution

- Brief Working Group, elevate/resolve issues and begin development
- Deliver enhancements incrementally






