
On the day of the panel, panelists use IPS to access reviews and proposals as well as write, edit, comment on, and approve panel summaries. To access IPS, go to the Research.gov homepage at www.research.gov, click the FastLane Panelist Functions link, and follow the instructions below.

Log into the system using the Panel ID and the password that you created for this meeting when you logged in to register for the meeting.




Note: If you lose or forget your password, you can contact your program office to request another temporary password be sent to you via email.
